Election of Board Officers

At the December board meeting the board unanimously elected Chris Calvert to continue as the board President. Also, Patrick Sweeney was elected as the new Vice President. Congratulations Chris and Pat! The newly elected Board Officers serve a two-year term commencing January 2022. The RNVWD Board of Directors serves the District without compensation. We are very thankful for all the board member’s dedication of time and service to the community. It is much appreciated by all the District members.

Arsenic Removal Facility, Well #2

In January we will be completing the design of the improvements for the removal of Arsenic from Well # 2 water. The construction documents are going out to competitive bid in February, and we expect completion of the new facility in mid-summer 2022. This new treatment plant will allow Well #2 to obtain approval from the state Division of Drinking Water, DDW, as an approved full time well to serve our needs as envisioned in the original design of the District. A new 150 KW stationary generator for Well #2 has been ordered and it is expected to be delivered and installed by May, 2022.

Water Conservation

Although we have been getting quite a bit of rain this year, let’s remember to stay focused on conservation of water as standard of practice. Our two wells are each 1400 feet deep and draw water from the very deep Aquifer the Basal Tehama Zone. Our ground water levels are monitored to ensure reliability.

Municipal Service Review, MSR

Solano LAFCO, (Local Agency Formation Commission) is working on the current update of the MSR. This is done by LAFCO every 5 years. It is expected that the MSR will be completed in the spring of 2022. The MSR will help to clarify the District's Sphere of Influence, SOI, and confirm other operating assumptions for the District based on the original design capacity of 533 connections. We currently have 398 active connections.
