NEW PAYMENT PROCESSING FEE STARTING JULY 1, 2025

Starting **July 1, 2025**, all **credit and debit card transactions** will include a **3.00% processing fee**, with a **minimum fee of \$3.00 per transaction**.

This fee is set by the payment processor, not the District.

To avoid the fee, customers are encouraged to use **e-check (ACH) payments**, which remain **free of charge**.
